

Policy for Addressing Conflict Minerals

The mining of some minerals (tantalum, tin, tungsten, gold) produced in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and neighboring countries is a source of funds for armed forces involving serious human rights violations and environmental destruction in the mining process and such minerals are therefore designated as “conflict minerals”.

To give effect to the Group's corporate social responsibility in relation to conflict minerals, we will promote initiatives that use materials (raw materials, parts, products, etc.) which do not use or contain conflict minerals.

We will also actively cooperate with investigations into conflict minerals undertaken by our customers and will engage in elimination of conflict minerals and responsible procurement activities.
